A BILL FOR AN ACT

To make Kim Young Po eligible for naturalization as a citizen of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Kim Young Po, a citizen of Korea now residing
2 in Pohnpei State, by virtue of his compliance with the provisions
3 of section 204 of title 7 of the Code of the Federated States of
4 Micronesia, is declared eligible for Federated States of Micronesia
5 citizenship, subject to approval by the President of the Federated
6 States of Micronesia in the exercise of the power granted to him by
7 said section 204 of title 7 of the Code of the Federated States of
8 Micronesia.

9 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
10 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
11 law without such approval.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Kim Young Po, a citizen of Korea now residing
2 in Pohnpei State, by virtue of his compliance with the provisions
3 of section 204 of title 7 of the Code of the Federated States of
4 Micronesia, is declared eligible for Federated States of Micronesia
5 citizenship, subject to approval by the President of the Federated
6 States of Micronesia in the exercise of the power granted to him by
7 said section 204 of title 7 of the Code of the Federated States of
8 Micronesia.

9 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
10 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
11 law without such approval.
