

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 9 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-70, 5-95, 5-96, 5-103 and 7-122, by further amending section 301, as amended by Public Law No. 7-122, for the purpose of establishing an expiration date for those National election commissioners currently appointed to the respective States, and for other purposes.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 301 of title 9 of the Code of the Federated States of
2 Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 7-122, is hereby further amended to
3 read as follows:

4 "Section 301. Appointment. The President shall appoint a national
5 election commissioner for each of the four States with the advice and
6 consent of the Congress. National election commissioners shall not
7 concurrently serve as State election commissioners; provided, however,
8 that if any current National election commissioner is also serving as a
9 State election commissioner, he or she may continue to serve as National
10 election commissioner until such time as a new appointment by the
11 President becomes effective. Each national election commissioner shall
12 be a citizen of the State for which he is appointed to serve as national
13 election commissioner; provided, that national election commissioners
14 may be appointed by the President for the national elections occurring in
15 March 1993, and special elections resulting therefrom, and may serve
16 without advice-and-consent confirmation for those elections. All
17 appointments made prior hereto shall expire 90 days after the effective
18 date of this amendment, unless the names of said commissioners are
19 resubmitted to Congress and approved prior thereto."

20 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the
21 Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
