AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 20-125, by amending sections 2, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, by changing the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the states of Yap, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.
