## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-051, as amended by Public Law No. 9-070, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Law No. 9-070, to change the lapse date of the funds appropriated under subsection (1) of section 1 to September 30, 1998; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 9-051, as amended by Public Law No. 9-070, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 2 "Section 2. All funds appropriated by this act shall be 3 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in 4 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited 5 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds appropriated by this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or the President's 8 designee; PROVIDED, that no funds shall be obligated or 9 disbursed prior to a consultation among the allottee, the 10 chief executive officer, or officers, representing the 11 municipality affected by the proposed project or program, 12 and the representative to the National Congress then 13 representing Election District No. 2 of the State of 14 15 Pohnpei. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, 16 are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and 17 that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 18 appropriated. The authority of the allottee to obligate 19 funds appropriated by subsection  $(\frac{1}{2})$  of section 1 of this 20 21 act shall lapse as of September 30, 199#8. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by 22 23 subsection (1/2) of section 1 of this act shall not lapse."
