BE	IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
1	Section 1. Proposed amendment. It is hereby proposed
2	that section 8 of article IX of the Constitution of the
3	Federated States of Micronesia be amended to read as follows:
4	"Section 8. The Congress consists of one member
5	elected at large from each state on the basis of
6	state equality, and additional members elected from
7	congressional districts in each state apportioned by
8	population. Members elected on the basis of state
9	equality serve for a 4-year term, and all other
10	members for 2 years. Each member has one vote,
11	except on the final reading of bills. Congressional
12	elections are held biennially as provided by
13	statute. After May 11, 1998, Members elected on the
14	basis of state equality shall serve no more than
15	three consecutive terms; all other members shall
16	serve no more than six consecutive terms."
17	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by
18	the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
19	becoming law without such approval.
