## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-052, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Mos. 9-071, 10-46, and 10-69, to modify the uses of funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-052, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-071, 10-46, and 10-69, is hereby further amended to 2 read as follows: 3 "Section 1. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as may 4 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of 5 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending 6 September 30, 1996, for the purpose of funding infrastructure 7 needs, transportation systems, and other economic and social 8 projects, public projects and for other purposes in Chuuk 9 State and for Chuukese outside of Chuuk State.
