A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 20 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-25, 8-108 and 9-138, by adding a new section 418 of chapter 4, requiring air carriers to file flight schedules with the Secretary of Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure and to give 30 days notice of changes in flight schedules, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Title 20 of the Code of the Federated States
2	of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-25, 8-108 and
3	9-138, is hereby further amended by enacting a new section 418
4	of chapter 4 to read as follows:
5	"Section 418. Flight schedules of air carriers.
6	(1) Every air carrier and every foreign air
7	carrier shall file with the Secretary, and print
8	and keep open to public inspection, flight
9	schedules showing all flights scheduled between
10	points served by it, and showing to the extent
11	required by regulations all classifications, rules,
12	regulations, practices, and services in connection
13	with such air transportation.
14	(2) Flight schedules shall be filed, posted,
15	and published in such form and manner and shall
16	contain such information as the Secretary shall by
17	regulation prescribe; and the Secretary is
18	empowered to reject any flight schedule so filed
19	which is not consistent with this section and such
20	regulations.
21	(3) No change shall be made in any flight
22	*schedule, except after 30 days' notice of the
23	proposed change filed, posted, and published in
24	compliance with this section. Such notice shall
25	plainly state the change proposed to be made and

1	the time such change will take effect. The
2	Secretary may in the public interest, by regulation
3	or otherwise, allow such change, upon notice, less
4	than that herein specified, or modify the
5	requirements of this section governing the filing
6	and posting of flight schedules, either in
7	particular instances or by general order applicable
8	to special or peculiar circumstances and
9	conditions."
10	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval
11	by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
12	upon its becoming law without such approval.
