A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 50 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by amending section 205, to change the period of validity of passports from five years to ten years; by amending section 207, to raise the amount of the Passport Revolving Fund from \$40,000 to \$80,000; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 205 of title 50 of the Code of the
- 2 Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as
- 3 follows:

- 4 "Section 205. <u>Duration of passports</u>. A passport
- shall be valid for a period of fi/\sqrt{e} ten years from the
- 6 date of issuance or renewal."
- 7 Section 2. Section 207 of the Code of the Federated States
- 8 of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 9 "Section 207. <u>Passport revolving fund</u>.
- 10 (1) There is hereby created and established the
 11 Passport Revolving Fund, hereinafter referred to as
 12 the 'Fund,' separate from the General Fund of the
 13 Federated States of Micronesia and all other funds.
 - (2) The purpose of the Fund is to establish an ongoing revolving fund to allow appropriations for, and revenues from, the issuance and renewal of passports to be used for passport issuance and renewal.
 - (3) All future appropriations for, and revenues received from, the issuance and renewal of passports shall be deposited in the Fund; provided, that at no time shall the total amount of monies in the Fund exceed \$40/00080,000\$; and provided further, that any revenues received from the issuance and renewal of passports which would cause the total amount of monies

1 in the Fund to exceed \$40/00080,000 shall be deposited 2 in the General Fund of the Federated States of 3 Micronesia. Any unexpended monies in this Fund shall not revert to the General Fund nor lapse at the end of 5 the fiscal year. 6 (4) The Fund shall be administered by the Chief 7 of the Division of Immigration and Labor. The Chief 8 shall, not later than thirty days after the close of 9 each governmental fiscal year, submit to the Attorney 10 G¢r/e/r/allDepartment of Justice a complete report of the 11 activities and condition of the Fund for the fiscal year just closed. The Attorney General Secretary 12 13 shall, within thirty days of receipt of the report 14 from the Chief, forward the report to the President 15 and the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia. 16 17 The Public Auditor shall audit the Fund at 18 such times as the Public Auditor deems appropriate. 19 Section 3.
