## AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-19, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-72, 8-80, 8-107, 9-016, and 9-044, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-72 and 8-80, to modify the use of funds appropriated therein under subsections (1) and to exempt Public Law No. 8-19 from the lapse provisions of Public Law No. 9-040, and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 8-19, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-72 and 8-80, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The sum appropriated under section 1 of this act shall be apportioned as follows:

Section 2. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds

appropriated by Public Law No. 8-19 shall be exempt from the lapse

provisions of Public Law No. 9-040.

Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
