TENTH CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

SECOND SPECIAL SESSION, 1998 CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 10-222, C.D.1, C.D.2, C.D.3 PUBLIC LAW NO. 10-106

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-052, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-071, 10-46, and 10-69, and to further amend section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-094, 9-117, 9-144, 9-160, and 10-69, to modify the uses of funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-052, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-071, 10-46, and 10-69, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, for the purpose of funding infrastructure needs, transportation systems, and other economic and social projects, public projects and for other purposes in Chuuk State and for Chuukese outside of Chuuk State. The funds appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as follows:

(1) Statewide projects, other than salaries,

Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 9-052, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-094, 9-117, 9-144, 9-160, and 10-69, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The sum of \$2,200,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, for the purpose of funding infrastructure needs, transportation systems, and other economic and social projects, public projects and for other purposes in Pohnpei State. The funds appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as follows:
