

ELEVENTH CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

FIRST REGULAR SESSION, 1999 CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 11-19, C.D.1, C.D.2

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 10-119, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-132 and 10-139, for the purpose of allowing payment of additional overtime from funds previously appropriated and to appropriate \$17,065 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1999, for National Police overtime, notwithstanding section 509 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 10-119, as amended by
- 2 Public Laws Nos. 10-132 and 10-139, is hereby further amended to
