ELEVENTH CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

FIRST SPECIAL SESSION, 1999

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 11-77, C.D.1, C.D.2, C.D.3

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$36,297,199 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, to provide for the budgeted operating expenses of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, various programs, subsidies, grants and contributions; to establish a budget for compact sections 214(b), 215(a)(2), 216(a)(1), 216(a)(2), 216(a)(3) and 221(b); and to establish a development budget and appropriate funds available therefor under the Compact; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>Definitions</u>.
- 2 (1) "Budget book" means the document entitled <u>Proposed</u>
- 3 Budget FY 2000 for the National Government transmitted by the
- 4 President to the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia on
- 5 March 31, 1999.
- 6 (2) "Output" means that set of objectives set forth in
- 7 column 2 of the pages of the budget book, referred to in this bill,
- 8 under the heading "key result/output". An output is a general
- 9 policy objective, the achievement of which can be measured. An
- 10 output is part of a strategic focus and, when achieved, will result
- 11 in a certain amount or number of deliverables.
- 12 Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch.
- 13 The sum of \$14,790,784, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
- 14 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
- 15 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, for the
- 16 operations of the Executive Branch of the National Government during
- 17 fiscal year 2000. The sum appropriated by this section shall be
- 18 apportioned as follows:
- 19 (1) Office of the President
- 20 \$660,229 for the outputs set forth on page A-1-3 of the budget
- 21 book.
- 22 (2) Department of Foreign Affairs

- 1 (a) \$3,633,258 for the outputs set forth in pages A-2-3
- 2 through A-2-4 of the budget book and for the following additional
- 3 outputs:
- 4 (i) Providing efficient and responsive consular
- 5 services to FSM citizens and non citizens.
- 6 (ii) Providing administrative and other support to
- 7 the Joint Committee on Compact Economic Negotiations (JCN).
- 8 (b) Conditions on use of funds: Funds appropriated
- 9 under this subsection for JCN travel and representation expenses
- 10 shall not be available for obligation or disbursement until:
- (i) funds appropriated for such purposes under the
- 12 JCN budget have been exhausted;
- 13 (ii) JCN has provided a report to the Committee on
- 14 External Affairs of the Congress of the Federated States of
- 15 Micronesia, through its Chairman, on the use of funds already
- 16 obligated or disbursed, including a description of such use and an
- 17 allocation among the outputs for which it was used; and
- 18 (iii) JCN has consulted with said committee
- 19 concerning the planned use of the funds it is seeking to obligate or
- 20 have disbursed.
- 21 (3) Department of Finance and Administration
- 22 \$2,411,204 for the outputs set forth in pages A-3-3 through A-3-7 of
- 23 the budget book.
- 24 (4) Department of Economic Affairs
- 25 \$1,861,697 for the outputs set forth in pages A-4-4 through A-4-14

- 1 of the budget book.
- 2 (5) Department of Transportation, Communication and
- 3 Infrastructure
- 4 \$1,461,470 for the outputs set forth in pages A-5-3 through A-5-6 of
- 5 the budget book, noting that by adoption of S.C.R. No. 11-44, the
- 6 output for operation of the F.S.S. Constitution has been deleted and
- 7 an output for operation of the M.S. Caroline Islands has been added
- 8 and PROVIDED THAT the amount appropriated for the M.S. Caroline
- 9 Islands is not to exceed \$308,300 and the amount appropriated for
- 10 the M.S. Caroline Voyager is not to exceed \$386,965, both amounts
- 11 are included in the Department's total above.
- 12 (6) Department of Health, Education and Social Affairs
- 13 \$918,496 for the outputs set forth in pages A-6-4 through A-6-21 of
- 14 the budget book.
- 15 (7) Department of Justice
- 16 \$3,328,786 for the outputs set forth in pages A-7-3 through A-7-5 of
- 17 the budget book. Of the total funds appropriated, \$991,669 shall be
- 18 deemed to come from funds available under section 216(a)(1) of the
- 19 Compact of Free Association for marine surveillance.
- 20 (8) FSM Public Defender
- 21 \$515,644 for the outputs set forth in page A-8-6 of the budget book.
- 22 Section 3. Operating expenses of the Legislative Branch. The
- 23 sum of \$3,245,283, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
- 24 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
- 25 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, for the

- 1 operations of the Legislative Branch of the National Government
- 2 during fiscal year 2000 in order to achieve the outputs set forth in
- 3 pages B-1-5 and B-1-10 through B-1-11 of the budget book.
- 4 Section 4. Operating expenses of the National Judiciary. The
- 5 sum of \$1,006,617, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
- 6 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
- 7 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, for the
- 8 operations of the Judiciary Branch of the National Government during
- 9 fiscal year 2000 in order to achieve the outputs set forth in pages
- 10 C-1-6 through C-1-8 of the budget book.
- 11 Section 5. Operating expenses of the Public Auditor. The sum
- 12 of \$457,542, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
- 13 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of
- 14 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2000, for the
- 15 operations of the Public Auditor of the National Government during
- 16 fiscal year 2000 in order to achieve the outputs set forth in pages
- 17 D-1-7 through D-1-8 of the budget book.
- 18 Section 6. Operating expenses of agencies of the National
- 19 Government. The sum of \$823,339, or so much thereof as may be
- 20 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
- 21 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September
- 22 30, 2000, for the operations of the following boards, commissions
- 23 and agencies during fiscal year 2000. The sum appropriated by this
- 24 section shall be apportioned as follows:
- 25 (1) Micronesian Maritime Authority

- 1 \$395,445 for the outputs set forth in pages E-1-5 through E-1-6 of
- 2 the budget book.
- 3 (2) Board of Regents-COM
- 4 \$76,742 for the outputs set forth on page E-2-5 of the budget book.
- 5 (3) FSM Coconut Development Authority
- 6 \$209,334 for the outputs set forth on page E-3-4 of the budget book.
- 7 (4) FSM Banking Board
- 8 \$141,818 for the outputs set forth in pages E-4-5 through E-4-6 of
- 9 the budget book.
- Section 7. Special programs. The sum of \$2,423,990, or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
- 12 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
- 13 year ending September 30, 2000, for the following special programs
- 14 during fiscal year 2000. The sum appropriated by this section shall
- 15 be apportioned as follows:
- 16 (1) FSM Aquaculture Center
- 17 \$117,211 for the outputs set forth on page F-1-4 of the budget book.
- 18 (2) Joint Committee on Compact Economic Negotiations (JCN)
- 19 \$935,362 for the outputs set forth on page F-2-6 of the budget book.
- 20 (3) National Government Early Retirement Loan Repayment Fund.
- 21 \$1,371,417 for the repayment of the Asian Development Bank-financed
- 22 early retirement loan.
- 23 Section 8. <u>Grants, subsidies and contributions</u>. The sum of
- 24 \$4,266,944, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby
- 25 appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To authorize a one-time meeting allowance for the purpose of compensating the attendance at educational meetings of members of the Educational Task Force on the proposed constitutional amendments put forth to the voters during the July 1, 1999, Special Election, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Authorization. Notwithstanding any other 1
- provisions of the law, there is hereby authorized a special
- allowance to be called "Special Meeting Allowance".
- Section 2. Eligibility. Each member of the Educational Task 4
- Force on the proposed constitutional amendments put forth to the
- voters in the July 1, 1999, Special Election shall be eligible for a
- special meeting allowance in the amount of \$30 per day of meetings
- attended in connection with the educational program on the proposed
- constitutional amendments; provided that he or she was not given per
- diem, stipend, or any other form of allowance by any State
- Government or the National Government in excess of the \$30 per day
- meeting allowance. Any member who received per diem, stipend, or 12
- any other form of allowance in an amount less than the the \$30 per 13
- day meeting allowance may be paid the difference of the two. 14
- Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the 15
- President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming 16
- law without such approval. 17
