## TWELFTH CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 11-54, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 11-56, 11-63, 11-67 and 11-73, by amending section 6 to provide funding for the Office of National Election Director, and by further amending section 8, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 11-67 and 11-73, to provide funding for the special election to be held in Pohnpei State Election District No. 2 on June 30, 2001, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 6 of Public Law No. 11-54 is hereby amended to
 read as follows:

3 "Section 6. Operating expenses of agencies of the National <u>Government</u>. The sum of [\$1,701,498] \$1,815,498, or so much 4 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the 5 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the 6 fiscal year ending September 30, 2001, for the operations of 7 8 the following boards, commissions and agencies during fiscal year 2001. The sum appropriated by this section shall be 9 10 apportioned as follows:
