A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 12-12 by amending sections 10 and 13 to reappropriate and modify certain items previously vetoed, to change the designated funding source for certain items, and to adjust the amount appropriated to the trust fund "S" account to reflect the actual increase in Compact funding, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 10 of Public Law No. 12-12 is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 10. 14	the capital account funds available under section 211 of the

16	from the funds available under section 216(a)(3) of the
