A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 12-12, as amended, by further amending sections 2 and 16, as amended, to reallocate funds appropriated to the Office of the Public Defender for renovation of the Pohnpei Public Defender Office, to provide that such funds appropriated shall not lapse, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 12-12, as amended by
- 2 Public Law Nos. 12-21 and 12-24, is hereby further amended to read
- 3 as follows:
- 4 "Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch.
- 5 The sum of \$14,306,725, or so much thereof as may be
- 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
- 7 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
- year ending September 30, 2002, for the operations of
- 9 the Executive Branch of the National Government during
- 10 fiscal year 2002. Of the total funds appropriated under
- 11 this section, \$470,800 shall be deemed to come from the
- 12 funds available for communications under section
- 13 215(b)(2) of the Compact of Free Association. The sum
- 14 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as
- 15 follows:
- 16 (1) Office of the President
- 17 \$809,876, for the activities set forth in the
- performance budget pages A1.1 through A1.2 of the budget

1 book. 2 (2) Department of Foreign Affairs (a) \$3,771,123, for the activities set forth in 3 4 the performance budget pages A2.1 through A2.9 of the 5 budget book. (b) Conditions on use of JCN funds. 6 7 appropriated under this subsection for Joint Committee 8 on Compact Economic Negotiations (JCN) travel (\$50,000) 9 and representation expenses (\$55,000) shall not be 10 available for obligation or disbursement until: 11 (i) funds appropriated for such purposes under the JCN budget have been exhausted; 12 13 (ii) JCN has provided a written report to the 14 Committee on External Affairs of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, through its Chairman, on 15 16 the use of funds already obligated or disbursed, 17 including a description of such use and an allocation among the outputs for which it was used; and 18 19 (iii) JCN has provided to said committee, in 20 writing, signed by the JCN chairman and members, a 21 detailed description of the planned use of the funds it 22 is seeking to obligate or have disbursed. (c) Conditions of use of Washington D.C. 23 Embassy/JCN Representation funds. \$50,000 of the funds 24

appropriated under this subsection for representation

shall be for meetings between members and staff of the
U.S. Congress and members of the FSM Congress; PROVIDED

however that up to \$20,000 of these funds may be
reprogrammed for use by JCN for representation if all
section 2(2)(b) representation funds have been exhausted
and the requirements contained therein have been met.

- (4) Department of Economic Affairs \$1,373,627, for the activities set forth in the performance budget pages A4.1 through A4.18 of the budget book.
- Infrastructure \$1,500,773, for the activities set forth in the performance budget pages 5.1 through 5.3 of the budget book. Of the total funds appropriated under this subsection, \$25,000 for a consultant in communications policy shall be deemed to come from funds available under section 215(a)(2) of the Compact of Free Association for telecommunications.

22	"Section 16. Allotment and management of funds and

24	(1) General Provisions.
25	(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be

allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in 1 2 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979; 3 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for 4 5 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in 6 7 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess 8 of the sum appropriated. 9 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds 10 appropriated by this act are as follows: 11 (a) section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia; 12 (b) section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall 13 14 be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia: 15 (c) section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall 16 17 be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the 18 Federated States of Micronesia; (d) section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall 19 be the Public Auditor; 20 21 (e) section 6 through 13 - the allottee of these funds shall be the President of the Federated States of 22 Micronesia or his designee; EXCEPT THAT for the 23 24 following subsections of section 6 through 13 of this

act, the allottees shall be:

1	(i) section 8, subsection (5) - the allottee
2	of these funds shall be the Governor of the respective
3	State, or his designee;
4	(ii) section 8, subsection (6)(a) through

19	Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, or his
20	designee;
21	(vi) section 10, subsection (2)(c) - the
22	allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of
23	the Supreme Court of the Federated States of Micronesia;
24	(vii) section 13, subsection (1)(a) through
25	(1)(f) - the allottee of these funds shall be the

1	President of the College of Micronesia-FSM, EXCEPT THAT
2	the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
3	(1)(e) of section 13 shall be the Executive Director of
4	the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement Projects;
5	(viii) section 13, subsections (2)(a) through
6	(2)(d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the
7	Governor of the respective State.
8	(ix) section 13, subsection (13) - the
9	allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of Chuuk
10	State.
11	(3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to
12	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
13	of September 30, 2002, EXCEPT THAT the authority of the
14	allottees to obligate funds appropriated by section 13,
15	subsection (2) for post-secondary educational
16	assistance, and the authority of the allottee to
17	obligate funds appropriated by section 2, subsection
18	(8)(b) shall not lapse."
19	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
20	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
21	becoming law without such approval.
