A RESOLUTION

Ratifying the International Convention for the Suppression of the Financing of Terrorism.

- 1 WHEREAS, the International Convention for the Suppression of
- 2 the Financing of Terrorism ("the Convention") was adopted by
- 3 Resolution 54/109 of December 9, 1999, at the fourth session of
- 4 the General Assembly of the United Nations; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the worldwide escalation of acts of terrorism in all
- 6 its forms and manifestations continues to impact all countries;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, the financing of terrorism is a matter of grave
- 9 concern to the international community as a whole; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the Convention is of great importance for enhancing
- 11 international cooperation among countries in devising and adopting
- 12 effective measures for the prevention of the financing of
- 13 terrorism, as well as for its suppression through the prosecution
- 14 and punishment of its perpetrators; and
- 15 WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 25 of the Convention, the
- 16 Convention was open for signature and ratification by any Member
- 17 of the United Nations until December 31, 2001; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the Convention was signed by the President of the
- 19 Federated States of Micronesia on November 12, 2001; now,
- 20 therefore,
- 21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twelfth Congress of the Federated
- 22 States of Micronesia, Second Special Session, 2002, that the

1 Congress hereby ratifies the Convention;
2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
3 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
4 of Micronesia, the Secretary of the Department of Foreign Affairs,
5 the Secretary of the Department of Economic Affairs, the Governor
6 of each State and the Secretary General of the United Nations.
