A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 52 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by amending section 117 thereof to provide that the Economist and the Director of Administration and Budget of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia shall be exempt from the National Public Service System, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 (5) the Public Auditor; 2 (6) the administrative officer of the National Courts; 3 (7) the special assistants and secretaries to the President and Vice President and the secretary to 4 5 the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States 6 of Micronesia; 7 (8) persons appointed by the President to fill the following positions: Secretary of the Department of 8 9 Foreign Affairs, Secretary of the Department of Finance, 10 Secretary of the Department of Economic Affairs, 11 Secretary of the Department of Transportation, 12 Communication and Infrastructure, Secretary of the Department of Health, Education and Social Affairs, 13 14 Secretary of the Department of Justice, and the Chief 15 Public Defender, and their deputies, if any; 16 (9) persons appointed to any other positions by the 17 President with the advice and consent of the Congress; 18 (10) the Representative in Washington and all 19 ambassadors: 20 (11) persons or organizations retained by contract when the Personnel Officer has certified that the service to 21 22 be performed is special or unique and nonpermanent and 23

is essential to the public interest, and that, because of the degree of expertise or special knowledge required and the nature of the services to be performed, it would $$2\ {\rm of}\ 4$$

1 not be practical to obtain personnel to perform such 2 services through normal public service recruitment 3 procedures; (12) persons presently under contract of employment not 4 5 included in subsection (11) of this section, during the 6 life of such contract. No contract of employment shall 7 be entered into, renewed, or amended after the effective date of this chapter, except in accordance with the 8 9 provisions of this chapter; 10 (13) temporary positions, required in the public 11 interest, for which the need does not exceed six months; 12 (14) positions requiring part-time or intermittent work which does not exceed sixty hours in any calendar month; 13 14 (15) positions filled by inmates, patients, and students of institutions of the Federated States of 15 16 Micronesia: (16) members of any board, public corporation, 17 commission, or similar body, in their capacity as such; 18 (17) officers, faculty, and employees of the Board of 19 20 Regents and the College of Micronesia; 21 (18) positions specifically exempted by any other law 22 of the Federated States of Micronesia." 23 24 25
