Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, except that the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 1(1), 1(3) and 1(4) of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Kosrae; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 3(2)(a)(i) shall be the mayor of Kolonia Town; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 3(2)(a)(ii), 3(2)(a)(iv) and 3(2)(a)(v) shall be the Sokehs magistrate; and the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 3(2)(a)(iii) shall be the mayor of Nukuoro. allottee of the funds appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement Projects, except that the funds appropriated under section [4(2)(c)] 4(1)(c) of this act shall be allotted to [the President of the Federated States of Micronesia | Southern Namoneas Development Authority. (2) The allottees of the funds appropriated herein

(2) The allottees of the funds appropriated herein shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified herein, and shall report back to the Congress on the status of these funds no later than September 30, 2005. The authority of the allottees to obligate such funds shall not lapse until fully expended."
