A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 52 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by amending section 509 thereof to authorize overtime compensation to employees of the National Police for work done during certain emergencies and special operations, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 509 of title 52 of the Code of the
- 2 Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos.
- 3 10-62, 10-118, 10-151, 11-41, 11-52 and 13-43, is hereby further
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 "Section 509. <u>Freeze on salary increases; compensatory</u>
- 6 <u>time and overtime compensation</u>.
- 7 (1) Notwithstanding any other applicable law, there 8 is hereby enacted:
- 9 <u>(a)</u>[(1)] a freeze on annual salary step increases of 10 all employees in the public service system; and
- 11 $\underline{\text{(b)}}[\frac{\text{(2)}}{\text{)}}]$ compensatory time, with which employees in
- 12 the public service system shall be credited in lieu of
- 13 receiving overtime compensation as otherwise authorized
- 14 under the National Public Service System Act and
- 15 regulations promulgated thereunder. Compensatory time
- 16 means those hours authorized in advance and worked by an
- 17 employee outside established work hours and for which
- 18 the employee is credited with one hour in the form of

1 leave with pay for each hour of work an employee is 2. directed to work and performs in excess of the regular 3 40 hour workweek as provided by law. Compensatory time 4 shall be accrued by National Government public service 5 employees and shall be included in the compensation received by a program participant pursuant to subsection 6 7 (4)(c) of section 506 of this chapter; except that any 8 accumulation of time in excess of 280 hours shall be 9 forfeited unless taken before the end of the calendar 10 year in which the excess was accumulated. For purposes of computing whether a program employee's accrued 11 12 compensatory and /or annual leave hours are in excess of 13 280 hours, accrued compensatory time and annual leave shall be included in computing the 280-hour ceiling. 14 15 (2) [(3)] Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, 16 an employee shall be entitled to receive overtime 17 differential, retroactive to the effective date of Public Law No. 9-155, as authorized under the National 18 19 Public Service System Act, for: 20 (a) time worked in the event that the National 21 Government would be entitled to compensation for payment 22 of such differential under section 115 of title 50 and 23 section 416 of title 22;

(b) time worked in the event that the National

Government would be entitled to compensation for payment

of such differential through a written agreement with a legal entity that seeks to provide relief from emergency conditions, as long as the time worked is directly related to efforts to provide emergency relief, in accordance with an emergency declared by the President under article X, section 9, of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia;

- (c) time worked in the event that the National Government would be entitled to compensation for payment of such differential through a written agreement with the Water Users Corporation, as long as the time worked is directly related to management and maintenance of the Capital Water System; or
 - (d) time worked as follows:
- (i) by personnel within the Division of
 Budget in preparation of the annual budget submission at
 the discretion of the Secretary of the Department of
 Finance and Administration;
- (ii) by accounting personnel within the Division of Treasury in preparing the annual financial statements for the FSM National Government, at the discretion of the Secretary of the Department of Finance and Administration;
- (iii) by accounting personnel within the Division of Treasury in preparing reports pursuant to

section 226 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated 1 States of Micronesia, or a successor provision, at the discretion of the Secretary of the Department of Finance 3 and Administration. [Notwithstanding section 164 of 4 5 this title, persons working hours entitling them to 6 overtime differential pursuant to paragraph (d) of 7 subsection (3) of this section shall receive 8 compensation at straight time for those hours. (iv) by employees of the National Police in 9 10 response to a call from the President of the Federated States of Micronesia for them to stand duty during an 11 12 emergency, or a threat of an emergency, not subsequently 13 declared as an imminent emergency under article X, section 9 of the Constitution of the Federated States of 14 1.5 Micronesia, or during special operations approved by the 16 President of the Federated States of Micronesia, provided 17 that such Special Operations shall be limited to activities approved by the President in advance as 18 19 necessary for the safety, health and welfare of citizens 20 or visitors to the Federated States of Micronesia. 21 (3) [(4)] Notwithstanding other provisions of this 22 section, the employees of the National Weather Services 23 may receive annual increments retroactive to the 24 effective date of Public Law No. 9-155

(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 164 of

1	this title, persons working hours entitling them to an
2	overtime differential pursuant to paragraph (d) of
3	subsection (2) of this section shall receive
4	compensation at straight time for those hours."
5	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
6	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
7	becoming law without such approval.
