## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 13-46, as amended, by amending sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, and 9 thereof for the purpose of appropriating an additional sum of \$1,819,162 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, by repealing section 10, by amending section 12, and for the other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

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\$3,397,792, for the activities set forth in the performance budget pages 20 through 24 of the budget book. Of the funds appropriated, \$141,800 shall be deemed to come from carryover funds available under section 215(a)2 of Compact I for communications.

- (3) Department of Finance and Administration

  [\$2,795,932] \$2,835,932, for the activities set forth in the performance budget pages 73 through 77 of the budget book, provided that \$500,000 of this amount shall be used to fund a portion of the deficit recorded by the National Government at the close of fiscal year 2003, and further provided that said sum shall not be applied to the deficit until the Department has reported to Congress under oath as to the accounts in deficit, the amount of the deficit in each account, and the account(s) to which the \$500,000 will be applied.

  Of the funds appropriated, \$46,914 shall be deemed to come from carryover funds available under section 215(a)2 of Compact I for communications.

                (1) General Provisions.
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(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the Amended Compact of Free Association between the United States Government and the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia.

- (b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.
- (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds appropriated by this act are as follows:
- (a) section 2 the allottee of these funds shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;
- (b) section 3 the allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia;
- (c) section 4 the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated States of Micronesia;
- (d) section 5 the allottee of these funds shall
  be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
  Micronesia;

(e) section 6 through 9 - the allottee of these 1 2 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of 3 Micronesia; EXCEPT THAT for the following subsections of 4 section 6 through 9 of this act, the allottees shall be: 5 (i) section 8, subsection (6)(a) through (6)(d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief 6 7 Justice of the respective state; 8 (ii) section 9, subsection (1)(a) through 9 (1) (d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the 10 President of the College of Micronesia-FSM; 11 (3) Lapse Dates. The authority of the allottees to 12 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as 13 of September 30, 2005, EXCEPT that funds appropriated
