A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$[28,165,902] [7,369,742] 7,473,242 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, for the purpose of funding for the first quarter of the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, [the] certain operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; to establish a capital and human resource development budget, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
