A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-052, as amended, by amending sections 1 and 6 thereof for the purpose of changing the uses of certain funds appropriated for use in Chuuk State, changing the allottees of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-052, as amended by
2	Public Laws Nos. 10-46, 10-69, 10-106, 11-29, 11-61, 12-30 and 12-
3	70, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
4	"Section 1. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof
5	as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
6	General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
7	the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, for the
8	purpose of funding grants for infrastructure needs,
9	transportation systems, and other economic and social
10	projects, public projects and for other purposes in
11	Chuuk State and for Chuukese outside of Chuuk State.
12	The funds appropriated under this section shall be
13	apportioned as follows:

15	travel, and vehicles] grants:

5	"Section 6. <u>Allotment and management of funds and lapse</u>

7	(1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
8	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
9	accordance with applicable law, including, but not
10	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. <u>The</u>
11	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)
12	of section 1 of this act shall be the Chuuk State
13	Commission on Improvement Projects. [The allottee of
14	the funds appropriated under subsections (1) (a)
15	and(1)(b) of section 1 of this act shall be the
16	President of the Federated States of Micronesia. The
17	allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
18	(1)(c) of section 1 of this act shall be the Governor of
19	the State of Chuuk. The allottee of the funds
20	appropriated under subsection (1)(d) of section 1 of
21	this act shall be the Director of the Department of
22	Health Services, Chuuk State.] The allottee of the
23	funds appropriated under subsection (2) of section 1 of
24	this act shall be the Executive Director of the Chuuk
25	Housing Authority. The allottee of the funds

1 appropriated under subsections (3) and (4) of section 1 2 of this act shall be the Executive Director of the Chuuk 3 State Commission on Improvement Projects. The allottee 4 of the funds appropriated under subsections (5) (a), (5) (b) and (5) (c) of section 1 of this act shall be the 5 6 Tolensom Authority. The allottee of the funds 7 appropriated under subsections (5)(d), (5)(e), (5)(f) 8 and (5)(q) of section 1 of this act shall be the Mayor 9 of Polle Municipality. The allottee of the funds 10 appropriated under subsection (6) of section 1 of this act shall be the Northern Namoneas Development 11 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under 12 subsection (7) of section 1 of this act shall be the 13 14 Chuuk State Commission on Improvement Projects. The 15 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1) (b) (i) and (1) (b) (iii) of section 2 of this act shall 16 17 be the National Planner of the Federated States of 18 The allottee of the funds appropriated Micronesia. 19 under subsections (1) (b) (ii) and (1) (b) (v) of section 2 20 of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of Sokehs. 21 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections (1)(b)(iv) of section 2 of this act shall be the 22 National Planner of the Federated States of Micronesia. 23 24 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 25 (1)(c) of section 2 of this act shall be the Mayor of

1 Kolonia Town. The allottee of the funds appropriated 2 under subsection (1)(d) of section 2 of this act shall 3 be President of the Federated States of Micronesia or 4 his designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (1)(e) of section 2 of this act shall 5 6 be the Chief Magistrate of Nukuoro. The allottee of the 7 funds appropriated under subsection (1)(f) of section 2 8 of this act shall be the Pohnpei Port Authority. The 9 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 10 (1) (a) and (3) of section 2 and subsections (2) and (3) of section 3 of this act shall be the President of the 11 12 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, except 13 that the allottee of the funds appropriated under 14 subsections (3)(a), (3)(b), (3)(c) and (3)(d) of section 2 of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation 15 16 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under 17 subsections (1) and (4) of section 3 of this act shall 18 be the Governor of the State of Kosrae or his designee. 19 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 20 (5)(a), (7) and (8) of section 3 of this act shall be 21 the Mayor of Lelu Municipality. The allottee of the 22 funds appropriated under subsection (5) (b) of section 3 23 of this act shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipality. 24 The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 25 (5)(c) of section 3 of this act shall be the Mayor of

1 Utwe Municipality. The allottee of the funds 2 appropriated under subsection (5)(d) of section 3 of 3 this act shall be the Mayor of Malem Municipality. The 4 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (6) of section 3 of this act shall be the Speaker of the 5 6 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia or his 7 designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (6) of section 4 of this act shall be the 8 9 Mayor of Rull Municipality. The allottee of the funds 10 appropriated under the other subsections of section 4 of 11 this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap or 12 his designee. The allottees of funds apportioned under subsection (1) of section 2 of this act shall not 13 14 obligate or expend any of said funds for travel. The 15 allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these 16 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used 17 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that 18 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 19 appropriated.

20 (2) The authority of the allottees to obligate funds
 21 appropriated by this act shall not lapse."

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1	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3	becoming law without such approval.
