A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by repealing chapter 3 in its entirety and enacting a new chapter 3 to bring the FSM's Internal Budget and Finance Procedures into compliance with the amended Compact, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter 3 of title 55 of the Code of the
- 2 Federated States of Micronesia is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- 3 Section 2. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
- 4 Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
- 5 new chapter 3 entitled "Internal Fiscal Procedures for Compact
- 6 <u>Implementation</u>".
- 7 Section 3. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
- 8 Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
- 9 new section 301 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
- "Section 301. Purpose. The purpose of this chapter is
- 11 to establish fiscal procedures for the Compact period
- beginning in Fiscal Year 2004. The provisions set forth
- 13 hereinafter recognize the right of the State Governments
- and the National Government of the Federated States of
- 15 Micronesia to authorize the use of Compact funds in
- 16 accordance with their own respective laws, plans,
- 17 policies and prerogatives consistent with the terms and

1	conditions set forth in the Compact and contained
2	herein. The President is hereby empowered to ensure
3	compliance with such terms and conditions, and to ensure
4	accountable financial management of all Compact funds."
5	Section 4. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
6	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
7	new section 302 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
8	"Section 302. <u>Definitions</u> .
9	For purposes of this chapter only, the following terms
10	shall have the following meanings:
11	(1) 'Accrued Expenditures' means charges incurred by a
12	Government during a given period requiring the provision
13	of funds for: (a) goods and other tangible property
14	received; (b) services performed by employees,
15	contractors, sub-grantees, subcontractors, and other
16	third party non-contractors; and (c) other amounts
17	becoming owed under programs for which no current
18	services or performance is required, such as annuities,
19	insurance claims, and other benefit payments, all as
20	evidenced by a pending disbursements report.
21	(2) 'Annual Report' means the Annual Report of the
22	President of the Federated States of Micronesia to the
23	Government of the United States in compliance with
24	Section 214 of the Compact.
25	(3) 'Compact' means the Compact of Free Association

1	as Amended, and its related agreements entered into by
2	the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia and
3	the Government of the United States and enacted as
4	United States Public Law No. 108-188, unless otherwise
5	specified herein.
6	(4) 'Compact Budget Request' means the annual Compact
7	funding request for the upcoming Fiscal Year and
8	estimated funding levels for the two subsequent Fiscal
9	Years.
LO	(5) 'Congress' means the Congress of the Federated
L1	States of Micronesia, unless otherwise specified herein.
L2	(6) 'Fiscal Procedures Agreement' means the 'Agreement
13	Concerning Procedures for the Implementation of United
L 4	States Economic Assistance Provided in the Compact of
15	Free Association, as amended, Between the Government of
L 6	the United States and the Government of the Federated
L7	States of Micronesia' entered into in connection with
L 8	the Compact.
L 9	(7) 'Fiscal Year' means each one year period beginning
20	October 1 and ending on the next following September 30.
21	Each Fiscal Year shall be designated by the number of
22	the calendar year in which such Fiscal Year ends.
23	(8) 'Government' means a State Government or the
24	National Government of the Federated States of
25	Micronesia, unless otherwise specified

1	(9) 'Grant Award' means a formal offer of funds by the
2	Government of the United States to the Government of the
3	Federated States of Micronesia pursuant to the terms of
4	the Compact for the purpose of funding programs and
5	activities within a specific Sector.
6	(10) 'JEMCO' means the Joint Economic Management
7	Committee established pursuant to the Compact and the
8	Fiscal Procedures Agreement.
9	(11) 'Obligation' shall have the same meaning as
LO	defined in the respective Financial Management Acts of
L1	the Governments.
L2	(12) 'Operational Grant' means a grant associated with
L3	a Sector Grant program that continues from a given
L 4	period to a subsequent period as defined in Article I,
L5	Section 1 of the Fiscal Procedures Agreement.
L 6	(13) 'Original Compact' means the Compact of Free
L7	Association between the Government of the Federated
L8	States of Micronesia and the Government of the United
L 9	States in the form that was effective as of November 3,
20	1986 through September, 2003.
21	(14) 'Plan for the Division of Annual Economic
22	Assistance' means the comprehensive plan for the
23	division of economic assistance for a Fiscal Year,
24	including Annual Grant budgets by Sector, as described
) 5	in Article V. Section 1(b) of the Fiscal Procedures

1	Agreement, and may include such additional reports,
2	narratives, summaries, documentation and other
3	information as the President deems appropriate.
4	(15) 'Secretary' means the Secretary of the Department
5	of Finance and Administration for the Federated States
6	of Micronesia, or his successor in the executive
7	structure of the National Government of the Federated
8	States of Micronesia.
9	(16) 'Sector' means one of the six grant sectors
LO	described in Section 211(a) of the Compact and Article
L1	II, Section 1, of the Fiscal Procedures Agreement, as
L2	such sectors may be adjusted during the term of the
L3	Compact.
L 4	(17) 'Sector Grant' means the funds that are to be
L5	provided pursuant to a given Sector.
L 6	(18) 'State' means any of the states of the Federated
L7	States of Micronesia."
L 8	Section 5. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
L 9	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
20	new section 303 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
21	"Section 303. Division of Compact Funds among National
22	and State Governments. The chief executives of the
23	National Government and each of the State Governments
24	shall have the authority to, from time to time, enter
25	into one or more agreements setting forth the

1	proportionate amounts of Compact funds that shall be the
2	basis of each Government's Compact Budget Request under
3	section 305 of this chapter. An agreement regarding the
4	division of Compact funds may be limited to a specified
5	period of time and shall only be effective when signed
6	by the chief executive of each and every Government."
7	Section 6. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
8	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
9	new section 304 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
10	"Section 304. Compact Planning Estimates. No later
11	than November 15 of the Fiscal Year preceding a given
12	Fiscal Year, the President shall transmit the following
13	Compact planning estimates to each State Government:
14	(1) Estimated levels of Compact funding available to
15	each respective State for the upcoming Fiscal Year.
16	Such estimates shall:
17	(a) be in accordance with any agreement for
18	division of Compact funds entered into pursuant to
19	section 303 of this chapter that is effective for the
20	relevant Fiscal Year;
21	(b) reflect the Compact fund decrement; and
22	(c) reflect the amount of Sector funds that were
23	unobligated by each respective Government in the
24	previous Fiscal Year, which amount shall be added to the
25	estimated level of funding available to that Government

1	for the same Sector for the upcoming Fiscal Year.
2	(2) Estimated levels of Compact funding available
3	for the two Fiscal Years subsequent to the upcoming
4	<u>Fiscal Year.</u> "
5	Section 7. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
6	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
7	new section 305 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
8	"Section 305. Compact Budget Requests. No later than
9	May 15 of the year preceding a given Fiscal Year, each
10	State Government and the Secretary shall submit to the
11	President a Compact Budget Request for the upcoming
12	Fiscal Year. The Compact Budget Request shall not
13	exceed the estimated levels of Compact funding provided
14	to the respective Government pursuant to section 304 of
15	this chapter."
16	Section 8. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
17	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
18	new section 306 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
19	"Section 306. Plan For the Division of Annual Economic
20	<u>Assistance</u> .
21	(1) The President shall consolidate the Compact Budget
22	Requests into the Plan for the Division of Annual
23	Economic Assistance. No modification to a State's
24	Compact Budget Request shall be made in the
25	consolidation process without the prior consent of the

1	relevant State Government, except to the extent that
2	such Compact Budget Request exceeds the estimated levels
3	of Compact funding provided to that State Government
4	pursuant to section 304 of this chapter.
5	(2) No later than July 3 of the year preceding a given
6	Fiscal Year, the President shall submit the Plan for the
7	Division of Annual Economic Assistance to the Government
8	of the United States and shall transmit a copy to
9	Congress and to each State Government."
10	Section 9. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
11	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
12	new section 307 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
13	"Section 307. Grant Allocations - Approval,
14	Notification, Rejection.
15	(1) Upon receipt of notice of approval by JEMCO of
16	Sector Grant allocations, the President shall transmit
17	such notice to Congress and to each State Government.
18	(2) The National Government or any State Government
19	may reject all or any portion of its proportional share
20	of an approved Sector Grant allocation for the upcoming
21	Fiscal Year. Written notice of such rejection detailing
22	those portions rejected by amount and by Sector shall be
23	provided to the President not later than September 20 of
24	the current Fiscal Year.
25	(3) The President shall immediately transmit written

1	notification of any rejection of an approved Sector
2	Grant allocation to the Government of the United States.
3	(4) Except with respect to Compact funds rejected
4	pursuant to subsection (2) of this section or disputed
5	pursuant to section 308 of this chapter, each recipient
6	Government agrees to abide by all terms and conditions
7	enumerated in each Sector Grant Award, the provisions of
8	this chapter and the terms of the Compact, including the
9	Fiscal Procedures Agreement."
10	Section 10. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
11	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
12	new section 308 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
13	"Section 308. Appeal of Special Conditions.
14	(1) If, at any time, JEMCO or the Government of the
15	United States imposes, or notifies the Federated States
16	of Micronesia of its intent to impose, any special
17	conditions or restrictions on any Compact Grant Awards,
18	the President shall immediately notify any and all
19	affected State Governments thereof and provide such
20	Government(s) with copies of all relevant documentation,
21	including the explanation that is received from the
22	United States or JEMCO of the conditions and
23	restrictions and the reasons therefor.
24	(2) Any affected Government may dispute the decision
2.5	to impose special conditions or restrictions by

1	submitting a written appeal for reconsideration within
2	twenty (20) days of the Federated States of Micronesia's
3	receipt of the Grant Award to which such conditions or
4	restrictions were attached or the date notification of
5	the intent to impose special conditions was received by
6	the Federated States of Micronesia from the Government
7	of the United States, in accordance with the terms of
8	the Fiscal Procedures Agreement. Any and all such
9	appeals shall be addressed to the Government of the
10	United States and routed through the Office of the
11	President. The President shall submit any such
12	appeal(s) to the Government of the United States within
13	ten (10) days of his receipt thereof."
14	Section 11. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
15	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
16	new section 309 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
17	"Section 309. Grant Acceptance.
18	The President shall sign and return to the Government of
19	the United States each Grant Award, to the extent to
20	which it has been accepted, and shall transmit a copy
21	thereof to Congress and each State Government."
22	Section 12. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
23	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
24	new section 310 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
25	"Section 310. Review of Spending Authority Legislation.

1	(1) Prior to disbursement of Compact funds, the
2	Secretary and each State Government shall submit to the
3	President a copy of the effective legislation detailing
4	by Sector the allocation and spending authority for
5	Compact funds.
6	(2) If the Secretary determines that the proposed
7	spending authority contained in legislation submitted by
8	a Government differs from its proportional share of a
9	Sector Grant Award, the Secretary shall promptly notify
10	the Government of the relevant State and the President."
11	Section 13. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
12	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
13	new section 311 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
14	"Section 311. Compact Financial Assistance Fund.
15	(1) There is hereby created a "Compact Financial
16	Assistance Fund" to be administered by and under the
17	authority of the Secretary.
18	(2) The Compact Financial Assistance Fund shall be
19	established at a bank or commercial financial
20	institution organized in accordance with the laws of the
21	United States or a state of the United States; or,
22	subject to the approval of the Government of the United
23	States, a bank or commercial financial institution
24	organized in accordance with the laws of the Federated
25	States of Micronesia, in either case for the purpose of

1	receiving payments of Grant funds pursuant to the
2	Compact.
3	(3) The purpose of the Compact Financial Assistance
4	Fund is to account for Compact funds received from the
5	Government of the United States by the Government of the
6	Federated States of Micronesia on behalf of itself and
7	each of the States from the time of receipt of such
8	Compact funding and until such funding is disbursed to
9	the respective Government to which such funding accrues.
10	(4) The accounting records and accounts maintained for
11	the fund shall be in sufficient detail to provide a full
12	and complete accounting of Compact funds received by the
13	Federated States of Micronesia."
14	Section 14. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
15	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
16	new section 312 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
17	"Section 312. Operational Reserve Fund.
18	(1) There is hereby created an "Operational Reserve
19	Fund" to be administered by and under the authority of
20	the Secretary.
21	(2) The Operational Reserve Fund shall be an interest-
22	bearing account established at a bank or commercial
23	financial institution organized in accordance with the
24	laws of the United States or a state of the United
25	States; or, subject to the approval of the Government of

the United States, a bank or commercial financial 1 institution organized in accordance with the laws of the 3 Federated States of Micronesia, in either case for the 4 purpose of receiving payments of Grant funds pursuant to 5 Article IV, Section 5(b)(2) of the Fiscal Procedures 6 Agreement. 7 (3) Funds on deposit in the Operational Reserve Fund may be used to cover unanticipated delays of payments 8 9 from the Government of the United States of funds in respect of Grant Awards, provided that the Government of 10 the United States has approved any such use of funds. 11 12 (4) In the event of an unanticipated delay of 13 payments, the Secretary shall promptly notify the 14 President and the Government of each affected State. 15 (5) If requested by the Government of a State affected 16 by an unanticipated delay of payments, the President shall make reasonable efforts to obtain approval from 17 18 the Government of the United States for the use of 19 Operational Reserve Funds. 20 (6) Any unobligated funds remaining in the Operational 21 Reserve Fund as of the date of the final payment in 22 respect of Operational Grants during any Fiscal Year 23 shall be disbursed pursuant to section 317(5) of this 24 chapter. 25 (7) The Secretary shall pay all interest and other

1	earnings on the Operational Reserve Account to the
2	Government of the United States pursuant to Article IV,
3	Section 5(b)(2) of the Fiscal Procedures Agreement.
4	(8) If the President and the Government of every State
5	agree that the Operational Reserve Account is no longer
6	necessary, the President shall use reasonable efforts to
7	obtain the consent of the Government of the United
8	States to discontinue its use."
9	Section 15. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
10	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
11	new section 313 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
12	"Section 313. Infrastructure Maintenance Fund.
13	(1) There is hereby created an "Infrastructure
14	Maintenance Fund" to be administered by and under the
15	authority of the Secretary.
16	(2) The Infrastructure Maintenance Fund shall be
17	comprised of five interest-bearing accounts, one for
18	each Government, established at a bank or commercial
19	financial institution organized in accordance with the
20	laws of the United States or a State of the United
21	States; or, subject to the approval of the Government of
22	the United States, a bank or commercial financial
23	institution organized in accordance with the laws of the
24	Federated States of Micronesia, in either case for the
25	purpose of receiving infrastructure maintenance

1	contributions from the Government of the United States
2	and the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia
3	pursuant to Article VII, Section 7 of the Fiscal
4	Procedures Agreement.
5	(3) Not later than February 15 of each Fiscal Year,
6	each Government shall contribute from non-Compact
7	sources not less than five percent of its proportional
8	share of annual public infrastructure grants for that
9	Fiscal Year to the Infrastructure Maintenance Fund,
10	provided that a Government may delay such contribution,
11	or any portion thereof, until August 1 of that Fiscal
12	Year by written notification thereof to the President.
13	(4) The Secretary shall deposit the contributions of
14	each Government into that Government's account in the
15	Infrastructure Maintenance Fund.
16	(5) The President shall certify to the Government of
17	the United States, pursuant to Article VII, Section 7(b)
18	of the Fiscal Procedures Agreement, the consolidated
19	total amount of contributions to the Infrastructure
20	Maintenance Fund for each Fiscal Year:
21	(a) Not later than March 1 with respect to
22	contributions received on or before February 15; and
23	(b) Not later than August 15 with respect to
24	contributions received after February 15.
25	(6) The Secretary shall deposit matching contributions

1	received from the Government of the United States into
2	each Government's account in the Infrastructure
3	Maintenance Fund proportionally based upon the amount
4	contributed by each Government in that Fiscal Year.
5	(7) Not later than ninety (90) days after the end of
6	each Fiscal year, the President shall transmit an annual
7	financial report for the previous Fiscal Year, pursuant
8	to Article VII, Section 7(b) of the Fiscal Procedures
9	Agreement, showing all deposits into the Infrastructure
10	Maintenance Fund by the Government of the United States
11	and the Government of the Federated States of
12	Micronesia, the amount of income generated by the fund
13	and the fund balance.
14	(8) Each Government shall submit to the President an
15	annual infrastructure maintenance plan not later than
16	May 15 detailing the planned uses of funds available to
17	that Government from the Infrastructure Maintenance
18	<u>Fund.</u>
19	(9) The President shall submit to the Government of
20	the United States an annual infrastructure maintenance
21	plan not later than July 3.
22	(10) Funds on deposit in the Infrastructure Maintenance
23	Fund shall be utilized by each Government in accordance
24	with its infrastructure maintenance plan.
25	(11) The Secretary shall disburse available funds from

1	the Infrastructure Maintenance Fund account of a
2	requesting Government after:
3	(a) the requesting Government has submitted
4	Accrued Expenditure reports evidencing an authorized
5	expenditure or obligation of such funds; and
6	(b) the Secretary has determined that the
7	requesting Government has complied with each relevant
8	requirement under this section."
9	Section 16. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
10	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
11	new section 314 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
12	"Section 314. <u>Drawdown Procedures - Cash Disbursement</u>
13	to National and State Treasuries.
14	(1) Pursuant to Article IV, Section 5 of the Fiscal
15	Procedures Agreement, the Government of the Federated
16	States of Micronesia will receive an advance payment for
17	Compact Sector Operational Grants equivalent to two-
18	twelfths (2/12) of the annual total at the beginning of
19	the Fiscal Year and will receive advance payments
20	equivalent to one-twelfth (1/12) of the annual total at
21	the beginning of each subsequent month of the Fiscal
22	Year, except November.
23	(2) Any State Government or the Secretary may request
24	an accelerated disbursement of funds by submitting to
2.5	the President an Annual Cash Drawdown Schedule for

1 Compact Operational Grants for the upcoming Fiscal Year based upon appropriated budgets. The request shall 3 detail by month the Government's anticipated cash 4 disbursement requirements from Compact Sector 5 Operational Grants, and shall include supporting 6 documentation. 7 (3) The President shall use reasonable efforts to obtain the approval of the Government of the United 8 9 States for any accelerated disbursement of funds and shall promptly notify the affected State Government or 10 Secretary of a decision by the Government of the United 11 12 States. 13 (4) The Secretary shall request Cash Disbursement for 14 non-Operational Grants from the Government of the United States on behalf of each Government on the basis of 15 16 accrued expenditures pursuant to Article IV, section 5 of the Fiscal Procedures Agreement. 17 18 (5) Upon receipt of Compact funds, the Secretary shall 19 determine whether the amount and allocation of such 20 funds is consistent with the Sector Grant Awards. The 21 Secretary shall immediately notify the President and the 22 Government of any affected State of any discrepancy and 23 determine the cause. 24 (6) If the Secretary determines that Compact funds 25 have been withheld or suspended pursuant to Article IV,

1	Section 5(c) of the Fiscal Procedures Agreement, the
2	Secretary shall immediately notify the President and, if
3	the withholding or suspension affects a State, the
4	Government of that State. The Secretary shall withhold
5	from disbursement to the affected Government that
6	portion of the Compact funds not received as a result of
7	such withholding or suspension.
8	(7) Any Government whose Compact funding is withheld
9	or suspended pursuant to Article IV, Section 5(c) of the
10	Fiscal Procedures Agreement may dispute such withholding
11	or suspension through the Office of the President and in
12	the manner set forth in the Fiscal Procedures Act.
13	(8) Unless otherwise provided in this section, the
14	Secretary shall disburse funds from the Compact
15	Financial Assistance Fund to the National Treasury and
16	each State Treasury not later than the close of the
17	business day following the day upon which the Secretary
18	receives notice of the receipt of such funds."
19	Section 16. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
20	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
21	new section 314 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
22	"Section 314. Reprogramming/Re-Allocation of Compact
23	<u>Funds</u> .
24	(1) No Government shall re-allocate Compact funds from
25	one Sector to another Sector during the course of the

1	<u>Fiscal Year.</u>
2	(2) A Government shall reprogram funds within an
3	approved Sector Grant only upon receipt of the prior
4	written approval of the President.
5	(3) The President shall not unreasonably withhold
6	approval of requests for reprogramming of up to fifteen
7	percent (15%) of a Government's proportional share of a
8	total Sector budget or its proportional share of
9	\$1,000,000, whichever is less, within an approved Sector
10	Grant during the Fiscal Year; provided that such
11	reprogramming requests do not include and would not
12	require any of the following:
13	(a) any revision of the scope or performance
14	objectives of a Sector Grant or infrastructure project;
15	(b) an extension of the period of funding
16	availability;
17	(c) changes in key persons specifically named in
18	a Sector Grant award;
19	(d) the contracting out or otherwise obtaining
20	the services of a third party to perform non-
21	construction related activities (except general support
22	services) that are central to the purposes of the Sector
23	Grant; or
24	(e) any revision that would result in the need
25	for additional funding over and above the original

1	award.
2	(4) For proposed changes in Sector Grant budgets and
3	projects that would include or require any of the
4	revisions described or exceed the financial limits
5	provided in subsection (3) of this section, the
6	President shall use his best efforts to obtain the prior
7	approval of the Government of the United States."
8	Section 18. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
9	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
10	new section 316 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
11	"Section 316. Internal Quarterly Financial Reporting
12	Requirements. For each fiscal quarter, not later than
13	twenty (20) days after the end of such fiscal quarter,
14	each State Government and the Secretary shall submit to
15	the President the following reports:
16	(1) for all Governmental fund types:
17	(a) a statement of revenues and expenditures;
18	(b) a comparison of budget and actual
19	expenditures by function;
20	(2) with respect to Operational Grants, a budget
21	execution report for each function, including major
22	offices, cost centers, budget activities and performance
23	reports; and
24	(3) with respect to all Sector Grants, including the
25	matching share of the Infrastructure Maintenance Fund

1	provided by the Government of the United States:
2	(a) a Standard Form SF 269, or reasonable
3	facsimile thereof approved by the Government of the
4	United States; and
5	(b) a Federal Cash Transactions Report, or a
6	Standard Form SF 272, or reasonable facsimile thereof
7	approved by the Government of the United States."
8	Section 19. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
9	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by enacting a
10	new section 317 of chapter 3 to read as follows:
11	"Section 317. Compact Quarterly Financial Reporting
12	Requirements.
13	For each fiscal quarter, not later than thirty (30) days
14	after the end of such fiscal quarter, the President
15	shall submit to the Government of the United States a
16	consolidated report reflecting information provided in
17	each of the reports provided pursuant Section 315 of
18	this chapter."
19	Section 20. Title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of

14	Section 29. This act shall become law upon approval by the
15	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
16	becoming law without such approval.
