A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 3 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by amending section 301 thereof, concerning Congressional salaries.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 301 of title 3 of the Code of the
- 2 Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 "Section 301. <u>Compensation levels and allowances</u>.
- (1) Member compensation. Upon the presentation of credentials and qualification thereof, a Member of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia shall be
- entitled to receive compensation at the rate of
- 9 $\left[\frac{\$27,000}{\$18,000}\right]$ per annum as of the date his term of
- 10 office begins, and shall remain eligible therefor until
- 11 the Member's term expires or until a vacancy has been
- declared in his or her office.
- 13 <u>(2) Speaker compensation.</u> The Speaker, upon his
- 14 election as the Speaker, shall be entitled to receive
- compensation at the rate of [\$30,000] \$20,000 per annum
- 16 and shall remain eligible therefor until a new Speaker
- 17 assumes the office or until a vacancy in the Office of
- 18 the Speaker has been declared.
- 19 (3) Vacancies. A Member appointed or elected to fill

1	a vacancy in the Congress shall be entitled to receive
2	compensation upon taking the oath of office as a Member
3	of the Congress.
4	(4) Official expense allowance. [The] Each Member of
5	Congress is entitled to receive an official expense
6	allowance, which shall not exceed \$3,000 per annum.
7	(5) Representation expense allowance. Each Member of
8	Congress is entitled to receive a representation
9	expense allowance, which shall not exceed \$10,000 per
10	annum. The Speaker is entitled to receive an
11	additional \$5,000 per annum in representation expense
12	allowance."
13	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
14	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
15	becoming law without such approval.
