CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 15-75, C.D.1

PUBLIC LAW No. 15-28

AN ACT

To amend section 204 of title 7 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, in order to allow for citizenship through naturalization to FSM nationals and children of FSM citizens, and, with the recommendation of Congress through bill, citizenship through naturalization for spouses of FSM citizens, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 204 of title 7 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as 3 follows: 4 "Section 204. Naturalization. 5 (1) A person may be naturalized as a citizen of the Federated States of Micronesia in a manner or form 7 prescribed by laws or regulation if the person: (a) shall have lawfully resided within the 8 9 Federated States of Micronesia, whether prior or 10 subsequent to the effective date of the Constitution, for 11 at least five years immediately preceding the date of 12 filing his petition for naturalization; 13 (b) is a child of a citizen, or is a national, of 14 the Federated States of Micronesia; 15 (c) upon naturalization, shall have renounced 16 previous citizenship and allegiance to any and all 17 foreign powers and rulers, and submitted positive and 18 verifiable documentary evidence of said renunciations,

1	and taken an oath of allegiance in a manner and form
2	prescribed by law or regulation;
3	(d) has competence in at least one of the
4	indigenous languages of the Federated States of
5	Micronesia evidenced by passing a language examination
6	prepared and administered by the President or his
7	designee; and
8	(e) has not been convicted of a felony as defined
9	by the laws of the place where conviction took place.
10	(2) The President, on Congress' recommendation by bill,
11	may naturalize a person as a citizen of the Federated
12	States of Micronesia in a manner or form prescribed by
13	laws or regulation if the person:
14	(a) is in compliance with the criteria set out in
15	subsections 204 (1)(a), (c), (d) and (e), above; and
16	(b) is a spouse of a citizen of the Federated
17	States of Micronesia.
