

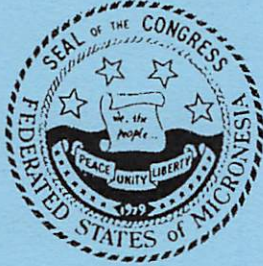

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AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 14-80, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 14-95, 14-99 and 14-104, the FY 2007 budget, by further amending sections 1,2,3, 7, 8 and 12 thereof, for the purpose of appropriating \$321,913 in supplemental funding from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, to readjust the amount of funds available through the Supplemental Education Grant, to provide for the operations of the Executive and Legislative Branches, national agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies, and contributions, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. The title of Public Law No. 14-80, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 14-95, 14-99 and 14-104, is hereby further  
3 amended to read as follows:

4               "To appropriate the sum of \$36,390,720.62 from the  
5 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for

7 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the

"Section 1. An annual budget in the amount of \$36,390,720.62 from for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007 is hereby approved. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007 the sum of \$36,390,720.62 for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; and capital and human resource development for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007. The sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:"

Section 3. Section 2 of Public Law No. 14-80, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 14-95, 14-99 and 14-104, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch. The sum of \$15,175,372 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, for the purpose of funding the operations of the Executive Branch of the National Government for the fiscal year 2007. 5 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
6 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in  
7 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess  
8 of the sum appropriated.

9 (2) Allottees. The allottee of the funds  
10 appropriated by this act are as follows:

11 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds  
12 shall be the President of the Federated States of  
13 Micronesia;

14 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds  
15 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated  
16 States of Micronesia;

17 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds  
18 shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the  
19 Federated States of Micronesia;

20 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds  
21 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of  
22 Micronesia;

23 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these  
24 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of  
25 Micronesia, EXCEPT THAT for the following subsections of

sections 8 through 9 of this act:

(i) section 8 subsection (7)(a) through (d)  
- the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice  
of the respective state,

(ii) section 8 subsection (7)(l) - the  
allottee shall be the Yap Office of the Public Defender,

(iii) section 8 subsection (7)(n) - the  
allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of the  
State of Kosrae.

(iv) section 8 subsection (7)(p) - the  
allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker of the  
Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia;

(v) section 8 subsection (7)(r) the  
allottee of these funds shall be the President of the  
College of Micronesia-FSM.

(vi) section 9(1)(a) through (d)- the  
allottee of these funds shall be the President of the  
College of Micronesia-FSM.

(3) Lapse Date. The authority of the allottee to  
obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as  
of September 30, 2007, EXCEPT the funds appropriated  
under section 9 of this act shall not lapse."

**Public Law No. 15 01**

1 Section 8. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.


