Dear Speaker Figir:

I am pleased to inform you that I have designated the following Congressional Act as Public Law No. 15-43:


Congressional Act No. 15-51, "AN ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 15-11, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 15-18, 15-26, AND 15-33, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, AND 9 THEREOF, IN ORDER TO APPROPRIATE AN ADDITIONAL \$727,537 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2008, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Note, however, that I have line item vetoed the following appropriations:

1. \$95,000 proposed appropriation for FSM Red Cross at page 22, line 4;
2. \$166,537 for Caroline Island Air, Inc. at page 25, line 11 of the bill; and
3. \$10,000 for the Construction of a Nahs at the official residence at page 27, line 23 of the bill.

Please also note that \$25,000 is the proposed supplemental increase for FSM Red Cross and therefore the intended amount to be line item vetoed. The line item veto therefore does not effect the \$70,000 appropriated under Public Law 15-11, as amended.

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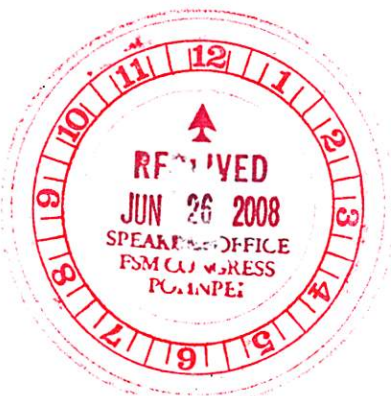

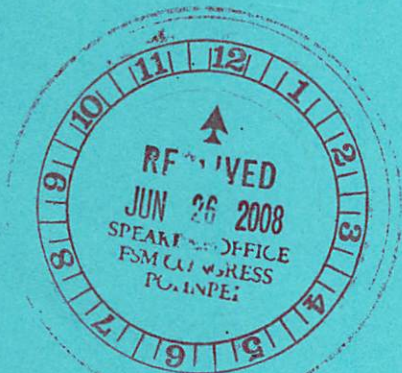

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26 and 15-33, by amending sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8 and 9 thereof, in order to appropriate an additional \$727,537 from the General Fund for fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The title of Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26 and 15-33, is hereby further amended
3 to read as follows:

4 “To appropriate the sum of \$43,055,348 from the General
5 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
6 fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, for the purpose
7 of funding the operations of all branches of the
8 National Government of the Federated States of
9 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,
10 subsidies and contributions and to establish a capital
11 and human resource development budget, and for other
12 purposes.”

13 Section 2. Section 1 of Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by
14 Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26 and 15-33, is hereby further amended
15 to read as follows:

16 “Section 1. The sum of \$43,055,348 from or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from
18 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
19 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, for the
20 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the
