I am privileged to return to you Congressional Act No. 15-70, which I have approved and designated as Public Law No. 15-63, entitled:

Congressional Act No. 15-70, "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 15-32, AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 1 AND 2 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE AND ALLOTTEE OF CERTAIN FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN FOR THE STATE OF POHNPEI, CHUUK, KOSRAE AND YAP, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Further, pursuant to section 2(c) article XII of the Constitution, I hereby item veto section 1(4)(f)(x) which is for Land Acquisition for the people of Halls, Weito and Pattiw Islands in the total amount of \$81,000. I have been advised that according to records this line item has already been depleted, therefore, the opportunity for an amendment thereof has passed.

11	Public Law No. 15-36 and 15-57, is hereby further amended to read
12	as follows:
13	"Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
14	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
15	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
16	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
17	limited to the Financial Management Acts of each of the
18	State, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the
19	amended Compact of Free Association between the United
20	States Government and the Government of the Federated
21	States of Micronesia and its related agreements. The
22	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
23	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
24	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
25	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum

1		appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
2		under subsections $(4)(a)$, (c) , (d) , (e) and (f) of
3		section 1 of this act shall be the Chuuk State
4		Commission on Improvement Project. The allottee of
5		funds appropriated under subsections 1, 3, and 4(b) of
6		section 1 of this act shall be the President of the
7		Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, EXCEPT
8		THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
9		(1)(1) of section 1 of this act shall be the Mayor of
10		Tafunsak Municipal Government. The allottee of funds
11		appropriated under subsection (2) of section 1 of this
12		act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap. The
13		funds appropriated by this act shall remain available
14		until fully expended."
