## A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the FSM has also signed the Revised Cotonou Agreement in December 2005;

WHEREAS, the Revised Cotonou Agreement complements and strengthens ACP and EC Partnership of which the FSM is a partner to ensure consistency with the new international agenda for development, deepens the political dimension of the partnership and broaden the cooperation framework to include new important security issues;

WHEREAS, ratification of the Revised Cotonou Agreement is necessary to ensure that the $F S M$ has access to the funding available under the $10^{\text {th }}$ Economic Development Fund;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Fifteenth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, Second Special Session, 2007, that the Congress hereby ratifies the Revised Cotonou Agreement, on behalf of the Federated States of Micronesia; and
