A RESOLUTION

Approving the \$4 million grant from the People's Republic of China submitted to the FSM in November 2007.

- 1 WHEREAS, the People's Republic of China originally donated a
- 2 grant of \$4 million to the FSM in July 2007 for the stated purpose
- 3 of assisting "emergency government reforms"; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the President submitted a request to the Congress
- 5 for approval of that grant during the Congress' September 2007
- 6 sessions, and the Congress failed to take action on the request
- 7 during those September sessions; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the Congress' inaction on the approval request
- 9 during the September session constituted a disapproval of the
- 10 grant by virtue of Title 55 Section 210(2); and
- 11 WHEREAS, subsequent to that disapproval, the People's
- 12 Republic of China by Exchange of Notes dated November 7, 2007,
- 13 with the FSM Department of Foreign Affairs resubmitted the grant
- 14 with specific conditions that the same "is to assist the FSM
- 15 Government on its efforts to carry out the reform in Chuuk State
- 16 and Kosrae State"; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the November submittal of the grant with new and
- 18 specific conditions by the People's Republic of China constituted
- 19 a new grant subject to a new approval of the Congress for purposes
- 20 of 55 FSMC 201(2); now therefore
