The intent and purpose of the resolution are expressed in its title.

The nomination of Mr. Johnny Meippen was transmitted to Congress via Presidential Communication No. 15-78. This communication reveals that Mr. Meippen's was recommended by the Governor of the State of Chuuk for re-nomination to serve on the National Oceanic Resource Management Authority (NORMA) and urges Congress to consider this nomination favorably.

Your Committee agrees with President Mori that Mr. Meippen's renomination to NORMA should be favorably considered.

Although no specific information regarding Mr. Meippen's qualifations was provided in connection with Presidential Communication No. 15-78, he has served as the Chuuk State member of NORMA since May, 2004. From information obtained in SCR 13-114 approved prior to Mr. Meippen's initial appointment, he has a distinguished academic background including an Associate Degree in Business Administration and Bachelor of Science degree from the College of Santa Fe, New Mexico, USA and finally a Masters Degree in Public Administration from the University of New Mexico. After completing his college education, he served in many public capacities within Chuuk State. Included were employment with the Chuuk State Department of Public Safety, service as legal counselor and later Directing Attorney, Chuuk State Micronesia Legal Services Corporation (MLSC), Assistant Legislative Council, Chuuk State Legislature and as Chief Litigator for the State of Chuuk. Your Committee agrees that Mr. Meippen was well qualified

On November 20, 2007 a public hearing was conducted at the Congressional Hearing Room in Palikir where your Committee invited comments from the Executive Director and Deputy Director of the Authority.
