A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend chapter 8 of title 41 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, by enacting new sections 802 and 803 to establish the standard of proper packaging and labeling of tobacco products, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter 8 of title 41 of the Code of the
- 2 Federated States of Micronesia, is hereby amended by adding a
- 3 new section 802 to read as follows:
- 4 "Section 802. Prohibition on tobacco packaging and
- 5 <u>labeling. No person shall distribute, import,</u>
- 6 <u>purchase for commercial purposes, or display</u>
- 7 tobacco:
- 8 (1) which contains on each unit packet and
- 9 package of tobacco products, and any outside
- 10 packaging and labeling any false, misleading,
- 11 deceptive or likely to create an erroneous
- 12 impression about the product's characteristics,
- health effects, and hazards or emissions, including
- 14 any term, descriptor, trademark, figurative, or any
- other sign that directly or indirectly creates the
- false impression that a particular tobacco product
- is less harmful than other tobacco products. These
- 18 may include, but are not limited to words or
- 19 descriptors such as "light", "mild", "ultra-light",

1	"less tar", "slim", or similar descriptors, or
2	graphics associated with such descriptors;
3	(2) unless the outside packaging and labeling
4	of each unit packet and package of tobacco
5	products, or wrapper in the case of cigars,
6	contains permanently affixed health warnings
7	describing the harmful effects of tobacco use, and
8	may include other appropriate messages as described
9	in relevant regulations. These warnings and
10	messages:
11	(a) shall be approved by the Secretary of
12	the FSM Department of Health and Social Affairs or
13	<pre>his/her designee;</pre>
14	(b) shall be rotating;
15	(c) shall be in English and/or the
16	respective state's local vernacular;
17	(d) shall be large, clear, visible and
18	<u>legible;</u>
19	(e) should be up 50 percent or more of the
20	principle display area; and
21	(f) may be in the form of or include
22	pictures or pictograms.
23	(3) unless the outside packaging and labeling of
24	each unit packet and package of tobacco products
25	contains, in addition to warnings, information on

Τ	the refevant constituents and emissions of the
2	tobacco product, in English and/or the respective
3	state's local vernacular, and as defined by
4	regulation;
5	(4) unless the package contains a package
6	insert, written in English and/or the respective
7	state's local vernacular, and complies with all
8	applicable regulations;
9	(5) which does not contain the name and license
10	number of the manufacturer, and as applicable,
11	wholesaler, importer, and exporter, permanently
12	affixed on its package, and on any larger package,
13	box, or container holding a number of tobacco
14	<pre>product packages;</pre>
15	(6) which does not contain the manufacture
16	serial number, lot number or batch number and the
17	name of the country in which it was manufactured;
18	(7) unless the unit packets and packages of
19	tobacco products for retail and wholesale use that
20	are sold in Federated States of Micronesia's
21	domestic market carry the statement: "Sales only
22	allowed in the FSM" or carry any other effective
23	marking indicating the final destination or which
2 4	would assist authorities in determining whether the
25	product is legally for sale in the domestic

1	<pre>market."</pre>
2	Section 2. Chapter 8 of title 41 of the Code of the
3	Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further
4	amended by adding a new section 803 to read as follows:
5	"Section 803. Regulations. The Secretary of the
6	Department of Health and Social Affairs may, from
7	time to time, promulgate such regulations as are
8	reasonably necessary to implement the provisions of
9	this chapter."
10	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by
11	the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon
12	its becoming law without such approval.
