A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 115 of title 52 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws 10-15 and 14-56, to eliminate the mandatory retirement age for employees subject to the National Public Service System, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this bill is to
- 2 effectively repeal the provisions of Public Law 14-56 establishing
- 3 a mandatory retirement age. This bill eliminates the requirement
- 4 for a mandatory retirement age.
- 5 Section 2. Section 115 of title 52 of the Code of the
- 6 Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws No. 10-
- 7 15 and 14-56, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 8 "Section 115. <u>Tenure</u>. [(a)] Every regular
 9 employee shall be entitled to hold his position
- 10 during good behavior, [subject to the provisions of
- 11 subsection (b) of this section, and to suspension,
- demotion, layoff, dismissal, or termination of
- employment through the Early Retirement Program,
- only as provided in this chapter or in chapter 5 of
- this title and in the regulations adopted in
- 16 pursuance thereof; provided, however, that the
- 17 tenure of a contract employee is the term of his
- 18 contract; and provided further that an employee who
- must submit his resignation pursuant to section 207
- 20 of title 2 of the Code of the Federated States of

1	Micronesia is not entitled to continued employment
2	with the National Government if he is not
3	renominated by the President or if he is not
4	reconfirmed by the Congress through advice and
5	consent proceedings."
6	[(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
7	title, no person may be an employee of the National
8	Government after the sixtieth anniversary of his
9	birth, except for those employees who are made
10	exempt from the National Public Service System by
11	section 117 of this title.] "
12	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
13	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
14	becoming law without such approval.
