## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia a supplemental funding in the total amount of \$9,744,053\$ for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, by further amending sections 1, 2, 8, and 9 of Public Law No. 16-7, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-20 and 16-25, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
