## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$53,044,445 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this act is to
- 2 appropriate the sum of \$53,044,445, or so much thereof as may be
- 3 necessary, from the General Fund of the Federated States of
- 4 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, for the

- 6 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies,
- 7 various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions. Of the
- 8 total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$4,403,240 shall be
- 9 deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from
- 10 the education sector; \$1,179,558 shall be deemed to come from
- 11 funds available under the Supplemental Education Grant; \$868,279
- 12 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact
- 13 from the health sector; \$416,121 shall be deemed to come from
- 14 funds available under the amended Compact from the capacity
- 15 building sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available
- 16 under the amended Compact from the private sector development
- 17 sector; and \$2,437,560 shall be deemed to come from funds
- 18 available under the amended Compact from the infrastructure
- 19 sector.
