A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia supplemental funding in the total amount of \$342,530 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, by amending sections 1, 2, 4, 6, and 8 of Public Law No. 16-7, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-20, 16-22, 16-25, and 16-35, to allow reprogramming of any budget line items for the Department of Foreign Affairs, by amending section 11 of Public Law No. 16-7, for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

The President shall report 23 to Congress within one month of the last day of each 24 financial quarter all amounts reprogrammed inter or 25
