## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 16-49, by amending the title and sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 thereof, to modify the use of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the States of Yap, Pohnpei, and Chuuk and to offer technical amendments thereto, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The title of Public Law No. 16-49 is

2 hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "To appropriate the sum of \$[2,940,000] 2,195,000
4 from the General Fund of the Federated States of
5 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
6 2011, for the purpose of funding public projects
7 and social programs in the four States of the
