Transmitted herewith is the following Congressional Act, which has become Public Law No. 16-32 without my signature.

Congressional Act No. 16-30, "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-18, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-24, BY AMENDING SECTION 1 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN FOR THE STATES OF KOSRAE, POHNPEI AND CHUUK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

This Congressional Act is another amendment passed by Congress soon after the last amendment introduced by Public Law No. 16-24, which became effective on February 12, 2010. I reiterate by reference the comments I made on Public Law No. 16-24 and Public Law No. 16-18 on the same subject in order for us to reexamine the Nation's policy on public project appropriation, to avoid appearances of indecision and weaknesses in government planning practices as shown by the constant amendment to public laws.

Based on the foregoing, I am constrained to allow this act to become law without my signature.

PUBLIC LAW No. 1

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-18, as amended by Public Law No. 16-24, by amending section 1 thereof, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein for the States of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
