Dear Speaker Figir:



I am pleased to inform you that I have designated the following Congressional Act as Public Law No. 16-68:

Congressional Act No. 16-65, "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-49, AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 1,2,3,4, AND 5 THEREOF TO MODIFY THE USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS IN THE STATES OF YAP, POHNPEI, AND CHUUK AND TO OFFER TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS THERETO, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

I like to express my appreciation to Congress for making the appropriate modifications and necessary technical amendments to specify the individual public projects and social programs that are to receive funds under this law. The appropriate modifications along with the technical amendments in this act, makes the appropriation and implementation process more fair and transparent. However, I have an important concern with certain inconsistencies in its content.

First, the amended appropriations under this act in particular for public projects and social programs for Election District 1, 3, 4 and 5 in the State of Chuuk is not consistent with the detail breakdowns. I have been advised by SBOC that the appropriation under this act, for Election District 1, 3, 4 and 5 is \$5,000 more than that which has been actually allocated for each Election District. There is a variation of \$20,000, in total, for all four Election Districts in the State of Chuuk.

Second, the amendments under this act for Chuuk State Election District 5 technically deleted in its entirety two itemized projects or programs to-wit, "Entrepreneur Subsidies" under Section 5(6)(f), which was allocated funding for \$6,000 and "Municipal Government Projects" under Section 5(6)(p) which was allocated funding for \$7,000 under Public Law 16-49. These are technical errors that appear in the act.

Please take note that I have line-item vetoed the following line: <u>page 8</u>, <u>line 25</u>. This particular line item proposes an increase from \$15,000 to \$28,000 for "Transportation needs" for Chuuk State Election District 5.

In accordance with the aforementioned concern, I would respectfully request Congress' further review of the subject Act during its next session to address these inconsistencies or discrepancies. My administration stands ready to further discuss and assist the members and staff of Congress in these matters.

Thank you in advance for your kind attention to this important matter.
