## AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$2,940,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the four States of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. The sum of \$2,940,000, or so much thereof as may
- 2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
- 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
- 4 September 30, 2011, for the purpose of funding public projects and
- 5 social programs in the four States of the Federated States of
- 6 Micronesia. The fund shall be apportioned on the basis of \$210,000
- 7 per member of Congress as follows:
- 8 Section 2. Of the sum of \$2,940,000 appropriated by this
- 9 act, \$420,000 is apportioned for Kosrae State for public projects
- 10 and social programs.

9	Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date. All
10	funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered
11	and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not
12	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall
13	be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may
14	be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act,
15	and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.
16	The allottee of funds appropriated under sections 2 and 4 of this act
17	shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
18	designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
19	section 4(1)(b) shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority and the
20	allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)(c) shall be the
21	Pohnpei Housing Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
22	section 3 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State. The allottee
23	of funds appropriated under subsections $5(1)(2)(4)(5)(6)$ , $(7)$ and $(8)$
24	of this act shall be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement Project
25	(CSCIP). The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of
26	this act shall be the Executive Director of the Northern Namoneas

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1	Social and Economic Development Authority. The funds appropriated by
2	this act shall remain available until fully expended.
3	Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
4	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
5	law without such approval.
