PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-24

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 16-18 by amending sections 1 and 2 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, and to offer certain technical amendments thereto, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The title of Public Law No. 16-18 is hereby

2 amended to read as follows:

3 "To appropriate the sum of \$3,301,000 from the General
4 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, for the purpose
6 of funding Economic and Social Projects and Programs in
7 the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for
8 other purpose."

9 Section 2. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-18 is hereby 10 amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. The sum of \$3,301,000, or so much thereof 11 12 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for 13 14 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, for the 15 purpose of funding Economic and Social Projects and 16 Programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and 17 Chuuk. The funds appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as follows: 18

Section 3. Section 2 of Public Law No. 16-18 is hereby
amended to read as follows:
"Section 2. <u>Allotment and management of funds and lapse</u>
date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used

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1	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
2	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
3	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
4	under section 1 of this act shall be the President of
5	the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
6	PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
7	sections 1(4)(a), (b), (d), (e) and (f) of this act
8	shall be the Chuuk Commission on Improvement Project
9	(CSCIP). The allottee of funds appropriated under
10	section 1(1) of this act shall be the Governor of the
11	State of Yap. The authority of the allottee to obligate
12	funds appropriated by this act shall not lapse.
13	Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
14	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
15	becoming law without such approval.
