PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-07

### AN ACT

To appropriate \$35,278,975 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 14 amended Compact from capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be
- 15 deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from
- 16 private sector development; and \$-0- shall be deemed to come from
- 17 funds available under the amended Compact from infrastructure

- 9 shall report to Congress within one month of the last day of each

- 12 Section 12. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
- 13 date.
- 14 (1) General Provisions.
- 15 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
- 16 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance
- 17 with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
- 18 Management Act of 1979.
- 19 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for
- 20 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
- 21 are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
- 22 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.
- 23 (2) Allottees. The allottee of the funds
- 24 appropriated by this act are as follows:
- 25 (a) Section 2 the allottee of these funds shall

13	8 through 9 of this act:
14	(i) Section 8 subsection (13)(a) through (d)
15	- the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the
16	respective State Supreme Court,
17	(ii) section 9(1)(a) through (b) - the allottee of the fund shall
18	be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM.
19	(3) <u>Lapse Date</u> . The authority of the allottee to
20	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of
21	September 30, 2010, EXCEPT the funds appropriated under section 9
22	of this act shall not lapse.
