9	are not reflective of the true value of the resources obtained
10	from the Exclusive Economic Zone of the Federated States of
11	Micronesia; now, therefore,
12	BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixteenth Congress of the Federated
13	States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 2010, that the
14	Congress requests the President to double all fees under fishing
15	access agreements within one year; and
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
17	resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
18	of Micronesia.
