A RESOLUTION

Requesting the President of the Federated States of Micronesia to establish national field offices for the Department of Health and Social Affairs and the Department of Education in each state. WHEREAS, the mission of the Department of Health and Social 1 Affairs is to promote and protect the health status and social 2 3 welfare of the citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia; and 4 WHEREAS, the mission of the Department of Education is to partner with the states to ensure all schools meet FSM 5 accreditation standards and follow established school curriculum; 6 7 and WHEREAS, the National Departments of Health and Social 8 9 Affairs and Education currently have little field representation or visibility outside Palikir; and 10 WHEREAS, there is a need for the Departments of Health and 11 Social Affairs and Education to collaborate with their 12 counterparts at the State level and to be more visible, 13 14 accountable, and responsive to the people's needs; and WHEREAS, placing key Department personnel in the States would 15 16 increase collaboration with the States and create synergies in the provision of services from both Departments; and 17 WHEREAS, the Departments of Health and Social Affairs and 18 19 Education can better fulfill their missions to serve the people by reaching out through national field offices; now, therefore, 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixteenth Congress of the Federated 21

2	Congress requests the President of the Federated States of
3	Micronesia to establish national field offices for the Department
4	of Health and Social Affairs and the Department of Education in
