## A RESOLUTION

Requesting the Honorable Linda Lingle, Governor of the State of Hawaii, to authorize the Hawaii Department of Motor Vehicles to initiate the process of administering the motor vehicle written test in the Yapese, Chuukese, Pohnpeian and Kosraean languages. 1 WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii is now home to a large Micronesian population numbering in the thousands; and 2 3 WHEREAS, many of the Micronesians in Hawaii are already licensed to operate motor vehicles and have the skills, knowledge 4 5 and experience necessary to safely operate an automobile; and 6 WHEREAS, many Micronesians in Hawaii fail the Hawaii written driver's test due simply to language difficulty and many more 7 choose not to seek a Hawaii driver's license at all due to the 8 language of the written test; and 9 WHEREAS, Micronesian citizens' troubles with the police are 10 11 largely due to lack of Hawaii driver's licenses, therefore these troubles would be greatly mitigated by offering the test in the 12 13 major Micronesian languages; and 14 WHEREAS, immigrants of other backgrounds are fortunate enough to have their language needs accommodated during motor 15 16 vehicle testing by the State of Hawaii; now, therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixteenth Congress of the Federated 17 States of Micronesia, Fifth Regular Session, 2010, that the 18 Congress requests the Honorable Linda Lingle, Governor of Hawaii, 19 to authorize the Hawaii Department of Motor Vehicles to initiate 20
