

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-18, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-24, 16-32 and 16-39, by amending section 1 thereof, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated for funding Economic and Social Projects and Programs for the States of Chuuk and Pohnpei for fiscal year 2010, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-18, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 16-24, 16-32 and 16-39, is hereby further amended  
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$3,301,000, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General  
6 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
7 year ending September 30, 2010, for the purpose of  
8 funding Economic and Social Projects and Programs in the  
9 States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk. The funds  
10 appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as
