Your Committee on Judiciary and Governmental Operations, to which  
was referred C.R. No. 16-28, entitled:

"A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE NOMINATION OF MR. HENRY E.  
ROBERT TO BE THE FSM NATIONAL ELECTION COMMISSIONER FOR  
KOSRAE STATE.",

begs leave to report as follows:

The intent and purpose of the resolution are expressed in its title.

Congressional Resolution No. 16-28 was transmitted to the FSM  
Congress on September 9, 2009 through Presidential Communication  
No. 16-53. The said resolution is a nomination of Mr. Henry E.  
Robert to the position of national election commissioner for  
Kosrae State. The P.C No. 16-53 contained the nominee's resume,  
which is summarized herein.

Your Committee has reviewed the qualifications of the nominee and  
notes that apart from the nominee's academic achievement, he has  
served extensive years with the Kosrae State's Department of  
Education, beginning as a classroom teacher, advancing gradually  
to Education Specialist, Administrative Officer and up until his  
last employment with Kosrae State as the Director of Education.

Both the President and the Vice President, after careful  
consideration and consultations, have the confidence that the  
nominee has all the qualifications for the position. In a letter  
dated September 24, 2009 to the Chairman of the Committee from  
Speaker Lyndon Jackson of the Kosrae State Legislature, the  
Speaker fully supports the nomination of Mr. Henry E. Robert to  
the position. Furthermore, in another letter dated September 24,  
2009 to Chairman Sitan from the Lt. Governor of Kosrae, the  
general consensus is that the leadership of Kosrae fully supports
