5 Micronesia in a number of capacities; and

6 WHEREAS, Mrs. Falcam served, up to time of her passing, as
7 the Librarian for the Pacific Collection at the College of
8 Micronesia-FSM, which position she held from 1979; and

9 WHEREAS, Mrs. Falcam also served as Librarian for the
10 Congress of Micronesia, and as a staff member of the Public
11 Information Office during the Trust Territory Administration; and

12 WHEREAS, Mrs. Falcam was a devoted and hard working
13 public servant who dedicated her professional career in
14 service to the College of Micronesia; and

15 WHEREAS, Mrs. Falcam was also known for her charitable
16 work, exemplified by her work with the Micronesia Red Cross
17 Society, the Committee on Rights of Children, and the Raffle
18 Committee for the College of Micronesia Endowment Fund; and

19 WHEREAS, Mrs. Falcam had a passion to improve the
20 welfare of the FSM people which was demonstrated by her great

1 spirit of understanding and dedication to helping others;

2 now, therefore,

3 BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixteenth Congress of the Federated
4 States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 2010, that the
5 Congress hereby expresses its sorrow and extends its deepest
6 sympathy and condolences to the family and friends of the late
7 Iris G. Falcam, Former First Lady; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
9 Resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
10 of Micronesia, the family of the late Former First Lady, Iris G.
11 Falcam, the Governor of Pohnpei State and the Speaker of the
