

A RESOLUTION

To confirm the nomination of Ms. Mary Berngun Figir to serve as a Member of the Board of Regents of the College of Micronesia-FSM, representing Yap State.

1 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 706(1) of title 40 of the
2 Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, the Board of
3 Regents of the College of Micronesia- Federated States of
4 Micronesia (COM-FSM) is composed of five members; and

5 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 760(1)(b) of title 40 of the
6 Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, the President of
7 the Federated States of Micronesia appoints one member from
8 each State to serve on the College of Micronesia-FSM Board of
9 Regents; and

10 WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Yap recommends the
11 nomination of Ms. Mary Berngun Figir to serve as the Yap State
12 representative on the College of Micronesia-FSM Board of
13 Regents; and

14 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 706(1)(b) of title 40 of the
15 Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, the President has
16 nominated Ms. Mary Berngun Figir, to serve as the Yap State
17 representative on the College of Micronesia-FSM Board of
18 Regents for three years; and

19 WHEREAS, Ms. Mary Berngun Figir has served in various
20 capacities in both the public and private sectors in the State
21 of Yap, including State Director of Health Service for Yap

1 State, a paralegal/trial counsel for the FSM Public Defender
2 and student counselor, Community College of Micronesia, as well
3 as an advocate for Women's interests groups, and holds relevant
4 experience and qualifications which make her a suitable
5 candidate to serve on the College of Micronesia-FSM Board of
6 Regents; and

7 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 706(1)(b) of title 40 of the
8 Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, the nomination is
9 subject to the advice and consent of the Congress of the
10 Federated States of Micronesia; now, therefore,

11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixteenth Congress of the Federated
12 States of Micronesia, Fifth Special Session, 2010, that the
13 nomination of Ms. Mary Berngun Figir to serve as a member on
14 the College of Micronesia-FSM Board of Regents, representing
15 Yap State is hereby; and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
17 Resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated
18 States of Micronesia, the Governor of the State of Yap, the
19 College of Micronesia-FSM Board of Regents, and Ms. Mary
20 Berngun Figir.
