

A RESOLUTION

Expressing the profound sadness and sincere condolences of the Sixteenth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to those affected by the acts of violence perpetrated in Arizona and to the United States of America in this time of national tragedy.

1 WHEREAS, on Saturday, January 8, 2011, the United States of
2 America and the State of Arizona was shocked by an outrageous act
3 of violence at a public appearance of U.S. Congresswoman Gabrielle
4 Giffords; and

5 WHEREAS, Congresswoman Giffords and numerous others were
6 injured and six were killed in the senseless shooting, including
7 Chief Judge John Roll of the U.S. District Court in Arizona; and

8 WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia
9 recognizes the gravity of this tragedy and joins the United States
10 and all the families affected in mourning the occurrence of such
11 an unspeakable act of violence; and

12 WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia
13 condemns this senseless act of violence and prays those
14 responsible will be held accountable and brought to justice; now,
15 therefore,

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixteenth Congress of the Federated
17 States of Micronesia, Sixth Regular Session, 2011, that the
18 Congress expresses its profound sadness and its sincerest
19 condolences to those affected by the acts of violence perpetrated
20 in Arizona and to the United States of America in this time of

1 national tragedy; and

2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
3 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
4 of Micronesia, the United States Embassy in the Federated States
5 of Micronesia, and to the Speaker of the United States House of
6 Representatives.
